California Asian and Pacific Islander Legislative Caucus Endorses Dr. Angelo Farooq for State Senate

Accounting for about 16% of the state's population, Asian and Pacific Islander Americans (APIA) continue to be among the fastest growing racial and ethnic groups in the state. California is home to about one-third of the nation's APIA population. The California API Legislative Caucus was founded in 2001 and represents and advocates for the interests of the API community, including increasing API representation and participation at all levels of government, ensuring the API community has equal access to education, social services, health, mental health, and other government programs and services, and strengthening protections against hate crimes and defending the civil rights and liberties of APIs.

The CA API Legislative Caucus' endorsement comes on the heels of the California School Employees Association throwing their early support behind Dr. Farooq's campaign for State Senate. They join a burgeoning list of endorsements for Dr. Farooq's candidacy, including Lieutenant Governor Eleni Kounalakis, State Treasurer Fiona Ma, Attorney General Rob Bonta, State Controller Malia Cohen, scores of local leaders, and community members.
